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Uniform

Our School Uniform consists of:

- White polo shirt (with or without school logo) or white shirt/blouse
- Crew-neck sweatshirt/sweatshirt cardigan with school logo. (Not knitted/woollen cardigans or sweaters)
- Grey or black trousers, shorts, skirt, pinafore, culottes – not leggings
- Blue/white checked Summer school dress
- White, grey or black socks
- Black shoes (not trainers and no raised heels).

New uniform is supplied by Rosebuddies of Loughborough. This can be ordered online (and delivered to home or school) or bought from their stall on Loughborough Market.

The school has a selection of used school uniform for sale (50p per item), including branded sweatshirts. Stock is displayed in the main school reception at Pasture Lane.

Jewellery

Jewellery should not be worn in school with the exception of a watch and small stud earrings. Jewellery must not be worn during P.E lessons. This might seem unnecessary, but should accidental contact with an item of jewellery (i.e. an earring) occur, a harmless action may be turned into a serious injury. For similar reasons we also ask that long hair be tied back.

Medical issues If your child is suffering from any illness can you please let the office know as soon as possible (even if you are keeping your child at home). Particular attention should be given to chickenpox, measles and Strep A. This just allows us to stay informed at school.
