£750	Training	Continuing Professional Development of all relevant staff to ensure a high quality provision for Reading, Writing and Numeracy as well as Emotional Literacy.	The HT will be responsible for ensuring a high standard of quality teaching is a continued priority to support children in their Reading, Writing and Numeracy. Emotional Literacy will provide a focus for working with children with complex learning needs.
