Keeping warm at school

Our Covid risk management strategy includes the requirement to ensure adequate ventilation in classrooms, offices and other teaching spaces. This means that the windows are always open, and when CO2 levels are high, the doors are open too. Although the heating is on all the time, when it is cold outside, inevitably, it is also cooler inside too. Therefore, we would encourage the children to 'layer up'. This could mean wearing a layer beneath their shirt/t-shirt (vest/thermal top, etc), then their shirt/t-shirt, followed by their school jumper/ fleece. If wearing skirts or winter dresses, then tights are advisable. If wearing shorts, then maybe consider wearing long trousers on colder days—if your child complains of being cold at school.

It goes without saying that the children should be bringing warm/winter coats and hats/scarves/gloves on the colder days and they will be encouraged to wear these at break and lunchtime.
