Get the whole family involved!	<u>Scatch Project</u> Create a maze game on scratch like we have done in class. Can you add different levels and make it multi-player?	Quiz Design a quiz for your family. You will need to think of a set of question and answers which can be grouped into categories. Perhaps you could include forfeits or bonus questions.	<u>Secret Codes</u> Invent your own secret code and write a coded message.	<u>Diary</u> Can you record a written or video diary of your time in isolation? This will be something talked about in history lessons of the future!

Can you create an Easter <u>Garden?</u> Many churches and places of worship create Easter Gardens to remember and celebrate the sacrifice Jesus made. Use the internet to inspire you.
