## Emotional Support Sessions for Key Stage Two Pupils

As part of our ongoing Pupil Welfare provision, we are fortunate enough to offer our pupils free drop-in sessions with Mrs Sue Hack, who you may or may not know as a Licenced Reader at Hathern Church, St. Peter and St. Paul's. Mrs Hack is a qualified and experienced Emotional Therapist, who is offering our Key Stage Two pupils the opportunity to have an outlet, to share their worries and questions in much the same way that our school Nurse service provides, taking the form of quiet and confidential meetings available most weeks. This gives the pupils a chance to share their thoughts and concerns. Should pupils need further support, Mrs Hack will be able to pass on those concerns confidentially to Class Teachers, our School Nurse or Mr Dunn as appropriate.

These 'well-being' sessions are in addition to the School Nurse drop-in service, which while still available, is quite financially stretched in the current economic climate and so not as regular as any of us would hope for.

There is no obligation or expectation that pupils take up these sessions, but we do require that parents and carers provide their permission for their children to take advantage of this support, should they wish to do so in the future.
