

# HOMWORK EXPECTATIONS

## IN KEY STAGE 2

Year 6



### READING

We ask that children read **at least 3 x per week** at home. This reading should be logged on **Boom Reader**. If they have managed their three reads, the children will receive a raffle ticket for our **termly reading draw** to win a book.



### SPELLING

Every Monday, a spelling pattern/rule is taught. Children will practise these words every day in school. They will be set a home task on **Spelling Shed** to practise for **15 minutes**. They will receive 10 house points for completing the task.



### GRAMMAR

Children will be set **two weekly tasks** on **Rollama**. To complete these, they just need to achieve any medal (bronze, silver or gold) on the activity and will receive 10 house points.

On some weeks, this will be replaced with a whole class reading text to do instead.



### MATHEMATICS

For children who still need to practise their recall of  $\times$  and  $\div$  facts, a TT Rockstars task of 21 minutes will be set, varying in game type. Otherwise, children will be set weekly arithmetic questions available on paper and on Google classroom. Children will earn 10 house points for completing their maths homework.



Paper versions are available for maths and spelling upon request.

If your child receives any homework additional to those mentioned here, this is because **it has been identified that your child may need a bit of support** with a particular area of learning or may have a gap to fill after absence. Please support them in working on this.

Our aim and expectation is that **all** children complete their homework to reinforce class learning. If your child is struggling to access the homework, please speak to us. If children do not complete their homework, they will complete it in school on a Friday, where they can receive support to do this.
