Last year, the parish council provided some land within the Shepshed Road allotments to be developed as a managed wildlife area. The group has created a range of habitats there including a pond and has used recycled material wherever possible.

Come along and see what we have been up to! Children are welcome (under parental supervision) and you can help us build a bug hotel. It's a 10-minute walk from the village and there is a small carpark inside the allotments gate.
