
Character Comprehension

Today we are going to be having a closer look at the characters in the film, the moon creature and the robot.

We are going to be thinking about what we can see and then **inferring** how they might be feeling and what they might be thinking.





Character Role

Think about the two characters. For both the <u>robot</u> and the <u>moon creature</u>, I would like you to complete a character role sheet.


This involves writing <u>what we actually know</u> about the character on the <u>outside of the diagram</u>. This is what we can see and know is true just from watching the clip.

Then we will write what we can <u>infer</u> about the character's <u>thoughts</u>, <u>feelings</u> and <u>personality</u>, on the <u>inside of the diagram</u>.








The Robot

- 1. Write the name of the character at the top as your title
- 2. Write what you know about the character on the outside these are things you can see in the film
- 3. Write the things you infer about the character on the inside these are things you assume or think because of what you saw, for example, their thoughts, feelings and character.
