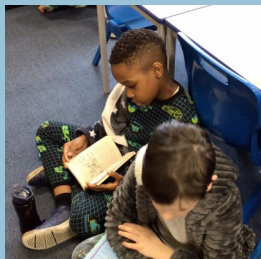
Farewell
