We will continue our big handwriting push alongside exploring simile poems. We shall then move on to exploring the story Stanley's stick. We will look at expanding our sentences using and or because. We shall also look at writing questions and using a question mark. We shall finish the term looking at the Easter Story.

Mathematics

This term children will build on their knowledge of the number system with numbers up to 50. We shall count, order and compare numbers as well as split them using tens and ones. We shall also work on our wider, practical Maths skills by measuring length, weight, height and capacity using non-standard and standard measures.
