The children have been brilliant in adapting to these measures and have acted responsibly and with understanding. They are a credit to you and the school.

As parents, I would ask that you remain vigilant over the half-term break though for all our sakes. I'm hoping the 9 days away from school will provide a 'firebreak' enabling us to come back to school on Monday 25th and enjoy an uninterrupted run up to Christmas.

Parents Evening Autumn Term 2021

As we had to cancel our planned parents' evenings this week, we have decided because of the recent surge in positive Covid cases to hold our Autumn Term Parents' Evenings remotely. In order to make the process as simple and straightforward as possible, we have bought into the <u>SchoolCloud</u> system again which we used previously in the Spring Term.



Today you should receive a text from school containing a link to our SchoolCloud portal (<u>https://hathernceprimary.schoolcloud.co.uk/</u>). You simply have to click on the <u>link</u> (using your phone, tablet, iPad, laptop or PC) and follow the instructions. Your login details will be your name, email, child's name and date of birth—no other usernames or passwords are required. Once 'logged in' you will be asked to select a time/day when you would like to 'meet' your child's classteacher. Sessions will be available across the 4 days—Monday 25th to Thursday 28th October. Bookings can be made from today (15th) until midday Monday 25th. Parents can 'invite' partners to join them on the meeting through the schoolcloud portal.

Once booked, you will receive an email confirming your appointment. To attend the appointment, you will need to follow the link contained in that email. It is important that you 'attend' the meeting on time as they are tightly scheduled and managed by the portal. By arriving late you will have less time to talk with your classteacher as the meeting will end as planned, regardless of when you joined the meeting.
