Covid update

Following the government announcement earlier this week about maintaining Coronavirus restrictions, I wanted to let you know that our Covid guidelines and Risk Assessments remain unchanged. Children will still be taught in their bubbles, handwashing will be frequent and where possible social distancing will be followed. This also means that, unfortunately, we still won't be admitting parents into school and would request that face masks are worn when dropping off/picking up your children. Charnwood currently (17th June) has the highest Covid infection rate in the County (83 cases/100,000 people) and we need to do our bit to prevent spreading in our village community. Some of the local Loughborough schools have been hit particularly hard these last two weeks having to close bubbles/whole classes causing disruption for all. I am anxious that we avoid this scenario at Hathern as the children have already missed enough time at school over the last 15 months. The summer holidays are just 3 weeks away and I am hoping that we can enjoy them without fear of an outbreak.
