## Parents Evening Spring Term 2021

If you haven't yet booked an appointment, then please follow the link to our SchoolCloud portal (<https://hathernceprimary.schoolcloud.co.uk/>). You simply have to click on the [link](#) (using your phone, tablet, iPad, laptop or PC) and follow the instructions. Your login details will be your name, email, child's name and date of birth—no other usernames or passwords are required. Once 'logged in' you will be asked to select a time/day when you would like to 'meet' your child's classteacher. Sessions will be available across the 4 days—Monday 22nd to Thursday 25th March. Bookings can be made until midday on Monday (22nd).

Once booked, you will receive an email confirming your appointment. To attend the appointment, you will need to follow the link contained in that email. It is important that you 'attend' the meeting on time as they are tightly scheduled and managed by the portal. By arriving late you will have less time to talk with your classteacher as the meeting will end as planned, regardless of when you joined the meeting.

## School Meals—Cross Street

School meals are now being delivered to Year 5 and 6 children at Cross Street. These are the same meals available at Pasture Lane, but brought up to the children ready to eat. By doing this, the Year 5 and 6 children no longer have to walk down to Pasture Lane saving valuable play time as well as further reducing any risks of transmission from one site to the other. Meals can be ordered on the day and paid online or in cash (£2.40/day).
