Annual Report to Parents

Today you should have received a paper copy of your child's Annual Report. This will provide you with an overview of their achievements across the curriculum this academic year. Please take the time to read and celebrate it with your child.

Although no statutory tests have been taken this year, teachers have formed an overall Teacher Assessment based on the knowledge they have of your child; this will include data derived from informal tests as well as through marking and observations. Due to lost learning time over the last 18 months, some of the children may be assessed as working just below where we would expect them to be for their age. This is not a major concern at this point. Your child's next class teacher will use this data to ensure the work provided is appropriate and catch-up strategies—like interventions—will be planned for many to help bridge the gaps.

Sports Day

We are delighted to share with you our plans for sports day this year. As part of our class swap day on Wednesday 30th June, we shall be holding an afternoon of sporting activities for all children to participate in. Children will be split into four colour groups and will compete for the winning title. The children should arrive at school in uniform but will change into their PE kit in the afternoon.
