



### READING

We suggest that children read **at least 3 x per week** at home. This reading can be logged on **Boom Reader**. If they have logged their three reads, the children will receive a raffle ticket for our **reading draw** to win a book.

Remember that all reading counts and is time well-spent! This includes an adult reading with a child before bed, a magazine, a cookbook - any reading at all can be logged on Boom Reader. **Please ensure reading books are returned on a Monday**, as they are needed for group reads.



We appreciate that it can be difficult to find time for homework and that your time at home with your children is precious. We also don't want to encourage additional screen-time. However, we do appreciate any extra practise that you are able to do with your child at home which supports in-school learning and practises skills. If you are struggling to access an online platform, or would like a paper copy, please speak to us.

### MATHEMATICS

There will be a weekly session of 21 minutes set on **TT Rockstars**, for pupils to practise their recall of times tables and related division facts. The site will measure their progress and move them on when they are ready.



### SPELLING

Each week, a spelling pattern/rule is taught. Children will practise these words every day in school. There will be a home task of 15 games set on **Spelling Shed** so that they can practise, little and often.



Our weekly learning update is emailed home on a Friday afternoon, so that you can see what all classes have been learning about that week.
