



HOMework EXPECTATIONS

IN KEY STAGE 2

Year 5

READING

We ask that children read **at least 3 x per week** at home. This reading should be logged on **Boom Reader**. If they have logged their three reads, the children will receive a raffle ticket for our **reading draw** to win a book.



Pupils can log their reading themselves too!

SPELLING

Each week,, a spelling pattern/rule is taught. Children will practise these words every day in school. They will be set a home task on **Spelling Shed** to practise for **15 minutes**. The practise is through short games and is best when completed little and often.



We appreciate that it can be difficult to find time for homework and that your time at home with your children is precious. We also don't want to encourage additional screen-time. However, we do see the value in any extra practise that you are able to do with your child at home which supports in-school learning and further practises skills

We also want to encourage pupils in upper KS2 to take some ownership over their learning and progress. We want to help them get into good routines for high school and meeting deadlines and expectations later in life.

The spellings and maths tasks will be set on a Friday. Our aim and expectation is that **all** children complete these tasks by the following Friday.

MATHEMATICS

Your child will be set a weekly task on TT Rockstars, to practise their recall of times tables and related division facts. The site will measure their progress and move them on when they are ready.

In year 5, pupils will be set **21 minutes** a week.



If your child is struggling to access an online platform, you are able to request paper copies. If they are struggling with the content of the tasks, then please speak to us so that we can support them.
